## Deck Application Required Document Checklist

### Please Note:

- All documents on this list are required.
- All the documents must be submitted at the same time
- We *cannot* accept singular documents that do not comprise a **complete** application.
- We cannot “hold” documents for you.
- We cannot accept singular documents by email.
- This list should be used in conjunction with information on our website.

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### 1. Residential Addition Building Permit Application:

- Signed and Dated by applicant
- Setbacks filled in
- Project cost filled in
- Contractor info including DC and DCQ License #'s filled in if applicant is contractor
- Description of deck including size, general location

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### 2. Cautionary Statement

- Must be signed if you are the homeowner doing your own work

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### 3. Zoning Documentation *Please check one:*

- Copy of Issued Land Use Permit from Pierce County
- Copy of Issued Zoning Permit from River Falls or River Falls ETZ
- Not Needed

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### 4. Plat Map/CSM *Please check one:*

- A copy of CSM with a legend that shows setbacks

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### 9. Design Load Specifications *Please check one:*

- Loads calculated and stamped by engineer
